Criteria for Nominations:

1. Nominee must be an individual, couple, group, nonprofit organization or for-profit company whose residence or offices are located in the 17 counties of Northeastern Pennsylvania.
2. Contributions of time, talent and/or treasure or in-kind donations have directly improved the health, education or general welfare of children between the ages of 0-18. OR
3. Efforts have substantially increased the awareness of needs of children.

Ineligible for nomination: schools and child care/early education providers
